LATHAM – The executive director of the Fiscal Policy Institute, a nonprofit research organization with a focus on fiscal public policy issues, will be retiring.

Frank Mauro, a previous deputy director of SUNY Albany's Nelson A. Rockefeller Institute of Government, took over the helm at FPI in 1993, two years after its founding. He has led the Institute for 22 years. Prior to his tenure at SUNY Albany, he was secretary of the NYS Assembly's Ways and Means Committee.

Mauro will one of the speakers at the 23rd Annual People State of the State Rally on Tuesday at the State Capitol.
